EDITORIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PUBLICATION

- size of the text for publication – 20,000 to 40,000 characters with spaces
- document format .doc or .docx
- Times New Roman font – size 12 pts
- space between lines 1.5 pts
- footnotes – font size 10 pts
- list of references at the end of the article before the summary
- summary up to 0.5 page in Polish and English
- key words
- citation and the list of references should follow the APA style, adjusted to Polish language standards
